Early this month, I posted about WWF's report on the dismal state of compliance with the FAO's voluntary <u>Code of Conduct for Responsible Fisheries</u>. Now <u>Rebecca Bratspies</u> notes on IntLawGrrls that FAO is scheduled to release its biennial report on the state of the world's fisheries on March 2, and that "[t]he news is not likely to be good." Bratspies points out that millions of women are hit especially hard by fisheries declines.
