9. Charles Koch co-founded the Cato Institute, a libertarian think tank dedicated to saving companies like Koch from the horrors of government regulation.

8. Fred Koch, who founded the company, was a charter member of the John Birch Society, the folks who thought Dwight D. Eisenhower was a Soviet agent.

7. A 2010 study listed Koch Industries as one of the nation's top-ten air polluters.

6. Koch is said to be the top oil company contributor to congressional races.

5. Koch has contributed almost \$25 million to funding organizations that promote climate denial.

4. Remember the <u>Federalist Society</u>? Turns out they also get <u>major Koch funding</u> (\$739,200 from 1997-2008).

3. Koch has an explicit policy of refusing to speak with media who might be unfavorable. Then they complain the stories are unbalanced.

2. Koch is pronounced "coke" but is actually more aligned with *Tea* Parties, which they have helped to launch.
