- 10. To send the nasty Koch brothers a message to stay out of California politics.
- 9. To send the nasty Texas-based Valero oil company a message to stay out of California politics.
- 8. To send the nasty Texas-based Tessoro oil company a message to stay out of California politics.
- 7. To send Meg Whitman a message that California wants environmental leadership (just in case she's elected governor).
- 6. To tell Congress that leadership on climate change legislation can be good politics.
- 5. Because the longer we wait to control our emissions the more expensive it will be to cut them later.
- 4. Because we need to send companies a consistent signal about what will be expected of them legally.
- 3. Because California's environmental leadership can provide a model for the rest of the country to follow (as it has so often).
- 2. Because environmental leadership produces technological leadership.
- 1. Because cutting greenhouse gas emissions is the right thing to do.
