

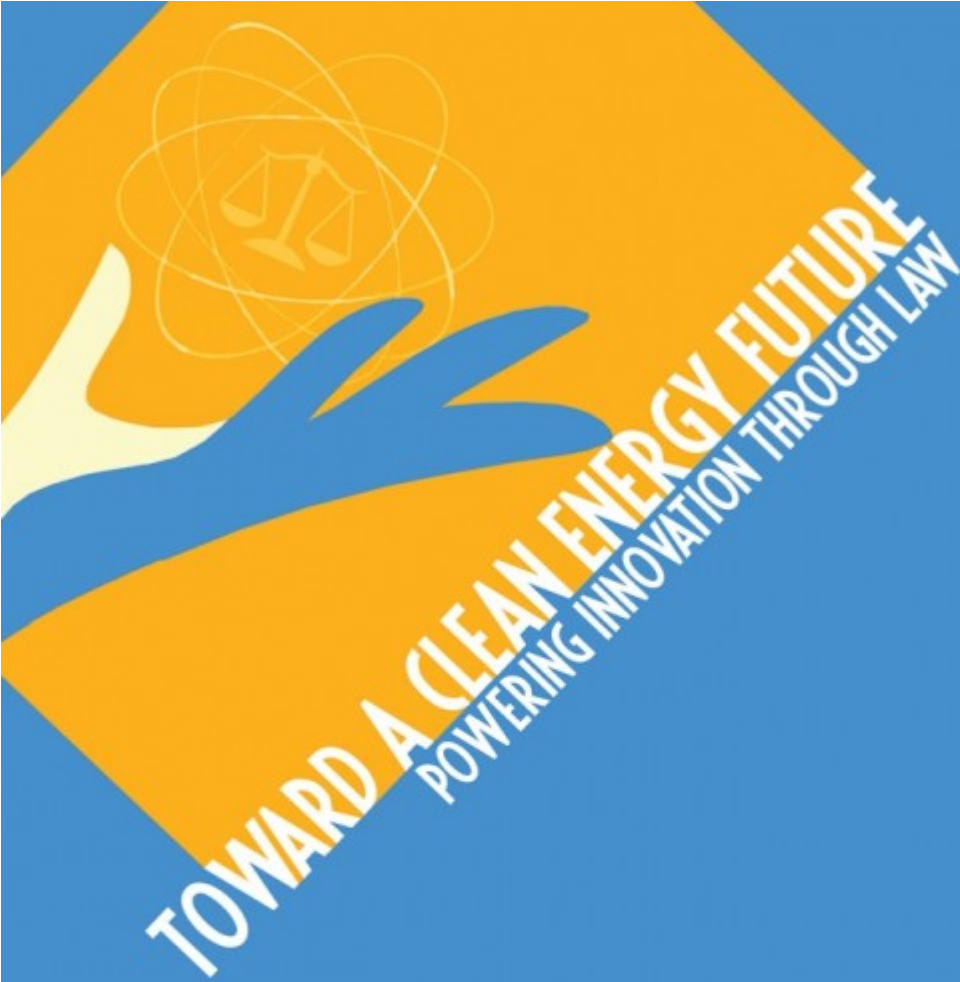
The UCLA Law Review is holding a symposium next Friday, November 1 - *Toward a Clean Energy Future: Powering Innovation Through Law*.
