A new Web-based <u>"dashboard"</u> is now available on EPA's Web site. Created by the Office of Policy, Economics, and Innovation, this site provides a transparent way to keep track of the agency's priority rulemakings. It provides users with earlier and more targeted information as well as special filters that allow users to find rules and related documents that interest them.

This tool should be especially useful to those tracking issues involving environmental justice, children's health, federalism, or other special interests. Currently, these are the most-viewed rulemakings:
