The <u>Adaptation Subcommittee</u> of the Climate Change Committee has done some excellent work to address adaptation issues. Besides planning, the Subcommittee has begun to <u>assess progress</u> to date, finding some improvements in capacity building but a lack of consistent implementation. The U.K. Climate Impacts Programme (UKCIP) offers some <u>nifty adaptation tools</u>, including an <u>Adaptation Wizard</u> and some great <u>background material</u> on risk and uncertainty. Altogether, a good model for others to follow.
