November 4th, the U.C. Davis School of Law's California Environmental Law & Policy Center hosted "CEQA at 40: A Look Back & Ahead." Celebrating the 40th anniversary of California's bedrock environmental law, the California Environmental Quality Act, the conference drew some 400 attendees to U.C.
